

PENNSYLVANIA KEY of HONOR AWARD

The KEY of HONOR is the highest award given by the Pennsylvania District of Key Club International. It is given to an adult - such as a Kiwanian, Advisor, Parent or Community Member - who has a record of outstanding contributions to the Key Club program or youth in general. The individual must, rather than simply do a good job, have gone beyond the scope of what is normally expected.

NOMINATION INFORMATION:

1. All nominations must be in notebook or portfolio form. This is for ease of handling only and has no bearing on how nominations will be judged.
2. All nominations must contain the following:
 - a. Biographical Sketch of Personal History
 - Community involvement
 - K-Family or other youth service affiliations
 - b. Letters of Recommendation: A maximum of four letters may be submitted. The letters may be divided into any categories desired. The following are recommended:
 - K-Family organization letters
 1. Kiwanis
 2. Club level
 - Community/Civic leaders
 - School
 - c. Applicant's History of Service
3. The selection of the recipient will be made solely upon the presentation received, rather than the District Board's knowledge of the nominee.
